**The Park not visited yet.**

Ravenfield Park is generally for Anglers and it has a number of small ponds. Ravenfield Village is famous for its 'Village in Bloom' which it has won on a few occasions and it is very pretty, it has a local church St. James and the village is close to Thrybergh Country Park which is well worth a visit.

- **Facilities** – There are no facilities, but Thrybergh Country Park is close by and there are a variety of Public Inns nearby.

There is a small car park in the Park.

- **Café** – At Thrybergh Country Park is an excellent Lakeside café.
- **Toilets** – There are no toilets in the Park.
- **Path** - The path in the Park is made up of rolled-in crushed stone but you will only be able to do part of the walk as there are steps on one section — see the map.  
Try and visit Ravenfield village in summer to view the 'Village in Bloom'.  
For walkers there are other paths and you can link this with Thrybergh Country Park.
