#### Greenwood Walk – B2

Colwick Country Park is close to Nottingham Race Course and Holme Pierrepont National Water Centre with a large lake, woodland and meadows providing a perfect backdrop for a variety of wildlife and recreational activities including fishing, water sports and many other leisure facilities. Cycling and horse riding are particularly popular, as the majority of paths in the area have been dedicated as a Public Bridleway whilst an excellent adventure centre keeps younger audiences entertained.

The park also has a rich diversity of wildlife from butterflies and dragonflies to a large number of birds that visit the park, especially at migration time.

Nestling within the sixty acres of parkland sits a magnificent Palladian style Georgian country house mansion that is currently being leased out and used as a prestigious hotel and function venue Colwick Hall Hotel

- **Facilities** – Trout fishing - Educational Facilities - Heritage Marina On Site - Orienteering - Picnic Areas – Adventure Centre – Play Areas - Public Transport – Bird watching – Ranger service - Wildlife Areas – Cycling – Horse Riding - Colwick Hall Hotel – St. John’s Church ruins.

There is a large car park amongst trees in the park, see the directions and map.

- **Café** – Close to Colwick Country Park is the National Water Sports Centre, which has a wide range of dining and refreshment options to suit any requirement and budget. In the Main building a restaurant is open 7 days a week offering almost everything you could need. You can pop in just for a cup of tea or go the whole hog and have a 3-course meal. The restaurant is perfect for when you have just finished your activity. Nearby are public houses.

- **Toilets** – There are disabled toilets near the adventure park.

- **Path** - The path is a good surface for wheelchairs It is made up of fine rolled-in crushed stone all the way round — it is suitable for all wheelchairs but manual wheelchairs will need a push up one slope, As this is mainly a waterside walk, the terrain is perfectly flat and the well-maintained paths make most of the walk suitable for wheelchair users, although there is a slight diversion during the walk to cater for wheelchairs.

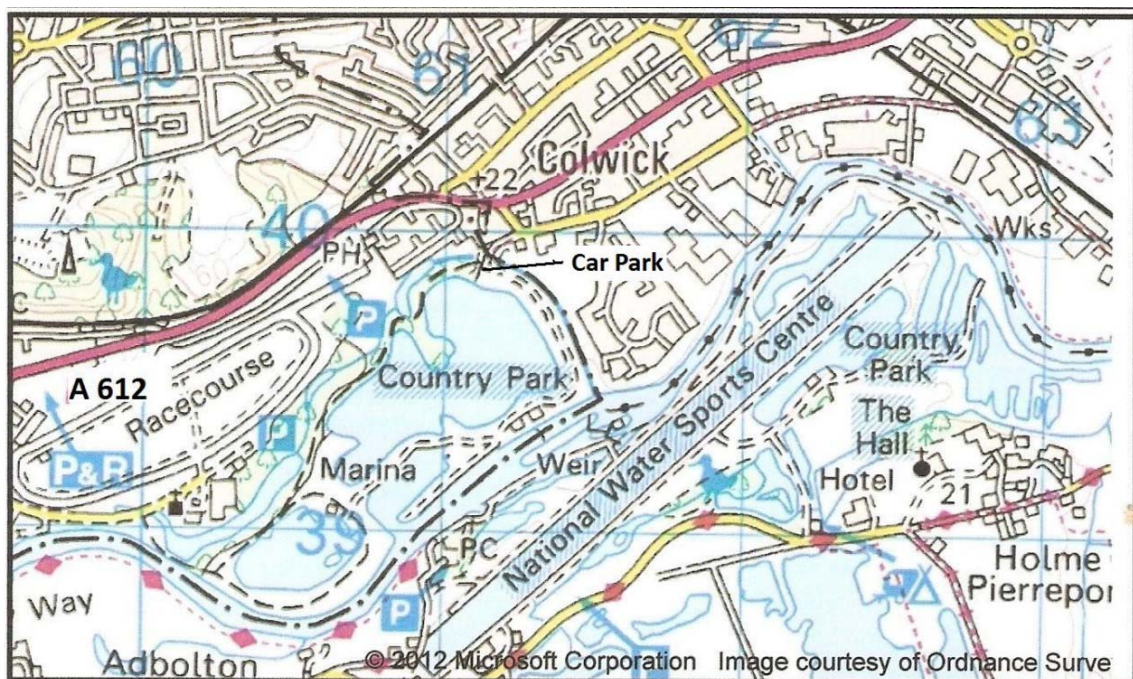

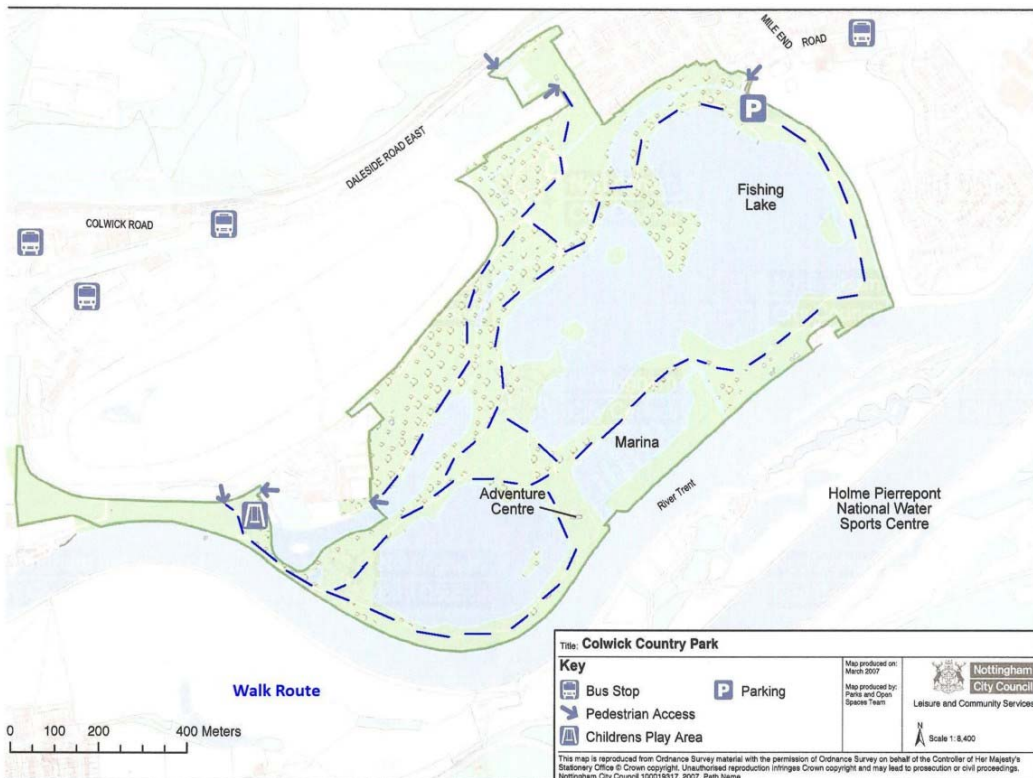
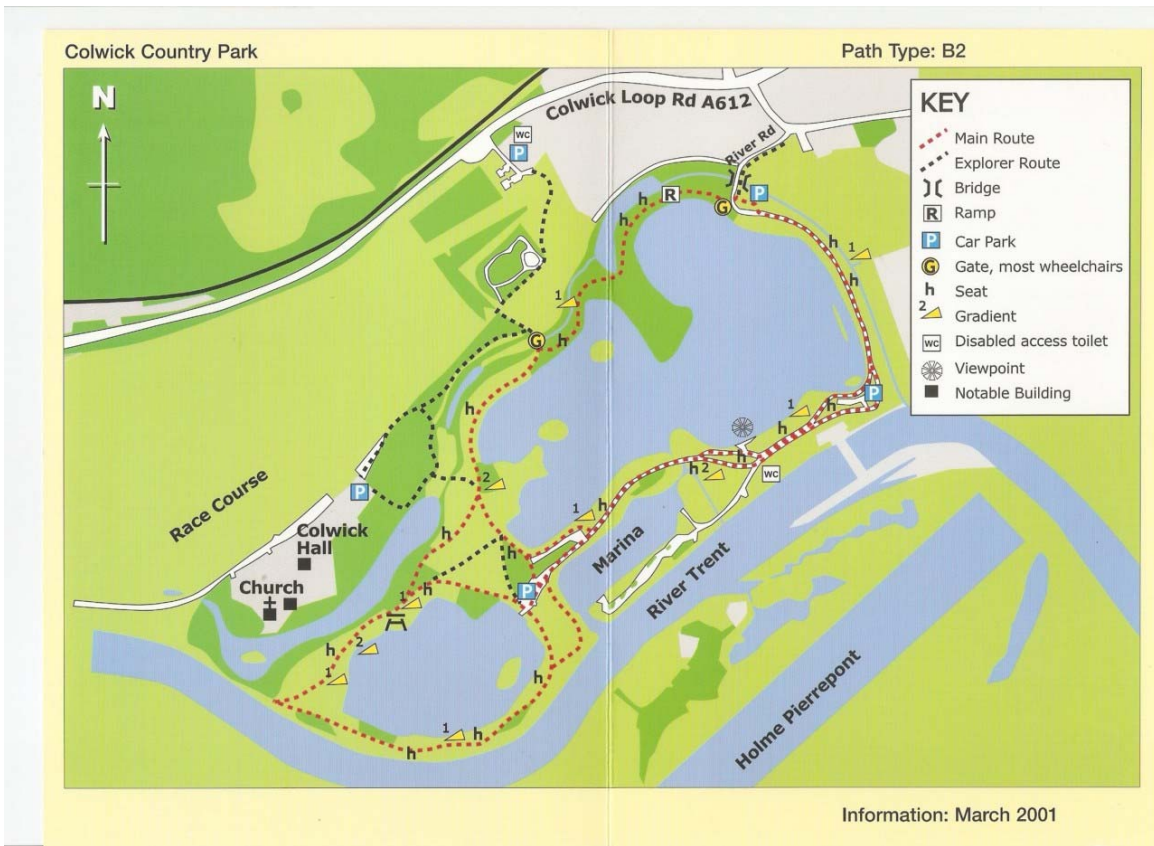

### Colwick Country Park



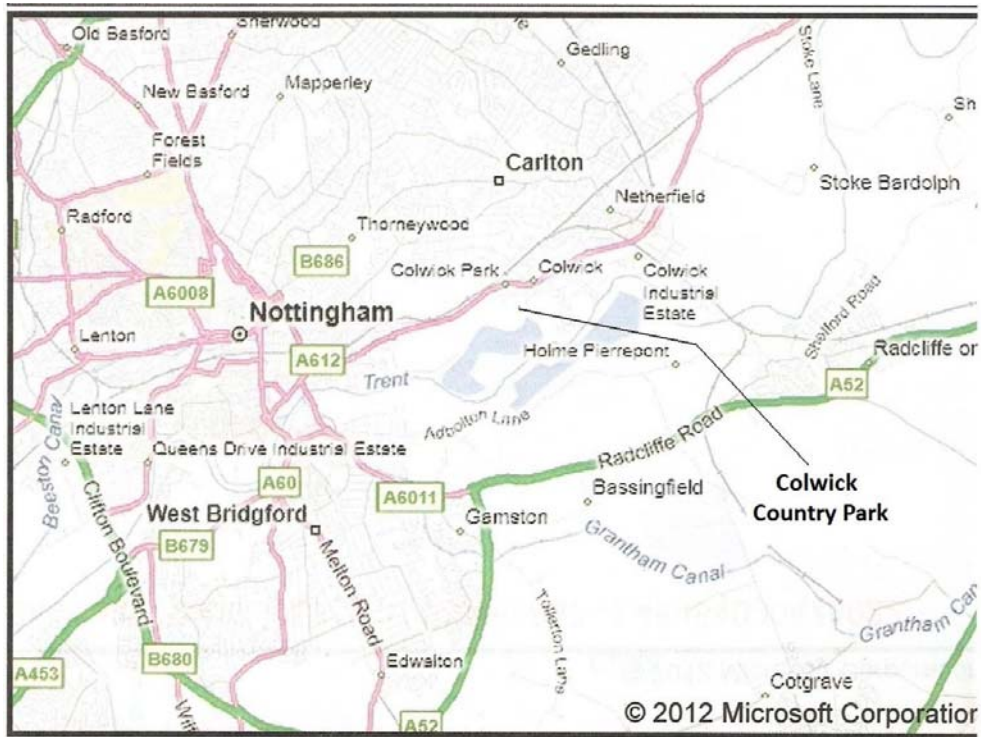
