The Nature Park not visited yet.

Following the Trans Pennine Trail north from Haw Park Wood you find the former Colliery site of Walton Colliery Nature Park with its ponds, grassland and wildlife, which has a good path network. In 2008 it was designated a Local Nature Reserve.

Anglers Country Park is also nearby – see website.

- **Facilities** –
You can park in the Nature Park off Shaw Lane
- **Café** – The New Inn Public House is close by for refreshments, also Anglers Country Park café is near – see location map
- **Toilets** – There are toilets at the New Inn.
- **Path** - The Trans Pennine Trail path from the Nature Park marked in green on the map is of rolled in crushed stone – but the paths in the Nature Park require checking for the suitability for wheelchairs – from the google maps a number of paths are indicated.

For walkers the Wakefield District health walk leaflet No. 19 shows a walk around Walton

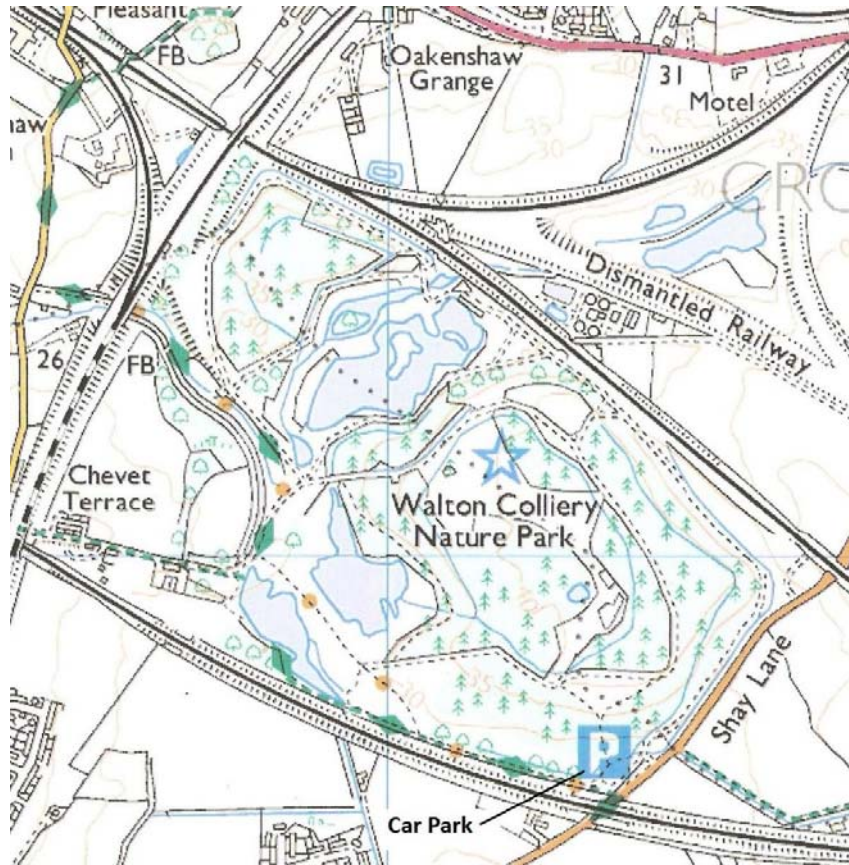
