Poolsbrook Country Park near Staveley was once the site of a Colliery and has been transformed into a country park for walking, fishing, children's play areas and many outdoor activities and amenities area. It has a woodland area and 3 lakes.

The park has become important for wildlife and has been designed to encourage wildlife diversity. Ornithologists are particularly pleased at the impressive range of birds attracted.

- **Facilities** – The site has a Visitor Centre that houses the Ranger base - Public Toilets, - Community meeting rooms, - Community Cafe. - Children's Adventure Play area - Picnic Sites - Sledging Slopes - Cycling trails - Horse Riding trails - Angling – Caravan Park.

There are 2 car parks; one at the Visitors centre and one near the fishing pond.

- **Café** – The Café in the visitors centre is open in the summer months on Saturday and Sunday from 10 to 4 p.m.

- **Toilets** - Well equipped toilets at the Visitors Centre.

- **Path** - The path is a good surface for motorised wheelchairs. It is made up of fine rolled-in crushed grey slate all the way around the lakes with a few slight slopes — manual wheelchairs will need a pusher.

Take the A616 towards Staveley / Barlborough then the A619 heading to Newark/Chesterfield - continue to follow the A619 for 2.6 miles - Turn left at Fan Road then go through 1 roundabout – then turn right at Meadows Drive – look for Poolsbrook Country Park near Cemetery lane.
