The Nature Reserve is excellent for bird watching, the nature enthusiast and wildlife photography. It has a variety of lakes and variety of birds visit throughout the year – there are many bird hives for viewing and getting up close to the birds with 10 suitable for wheelchairs – all the trails and hides are well marked. Guided walks can be arranged and it is visited throughout the year by many visitors, there is an events yearly programme with family activities and the reserve is a great day out for young and old alike.

There is a charge for visiting the Nature Reserve.

 Facilities – The main reception entrance has a sweet and gift shop – Cafeteria in the reserve centre with excellent food – 10 Viewing bird hives suitable for wheelchairs – Sensory Garden

There is a car park near the main reception centre, with disabled bays.

• Café – In the centre of the reserve is a Cafeteria with an excellent selection of food.





- Toilets Well equipped toilets at the main reception and café.
- Path Al the walks and hides are marked in a leaflet with a different colour for lengths of walks from 2 to 8 km. with at least 5 Km. suitable for wheelchairs, and these are being improved. The paths are of a good surface for wheelchairs and are made up of a mixture of fine rolled-in crushed stone and firm grass areas all the way round, generally flat with the odd slope. In summer trees and bushes around the paths restrict views for walkers in quiet a few areas it is suitable for motorised wheelchairs but manual wheelchairs will need a pusher in places.


Trail Routes
