Cusworth Hall has been described as the jewel in Doncaster's crown. The beautiful grade 1 listed building is set in acres of historic parkland with lakes, plantations and pleasure ground with dramatic views across the town. It was extensively restored between 2003-2007 and invites visitors to experience a wealth of architecture, heritage, landscape history, wildlife, exhibitions, events and activities.

The park aims to conserve the historic features of the 18th century landscape and the lakes are rich in habitat for many species of plants and bird life.

- Facilities Cusworth Hall Museum, Café and Shop Cusworth Park and Lake.
 There is a car park at the Hall with disabled bays.
- Café There is an excellent tea room and shop at the Hall. Cusworth Hall is open most times of the year, please visit the website to check.





- Toilets Well equipped toilets at the Hall.
- Path This is a short walk and the paths around Cusworth Park are suitable for wheelchairs, and are made up of a mixture of tarmac, rolled-in crushed stone and with some slabs around the lake, manual wheelchairs will require a pusher, as there are some slopes. The walk can be made longer by visiting Cusworth Village.




