The walk is around a pretty lake which has a variety of fowl & bird life and wild flowers and the park has a number of recreational facilities, children's adventure play areas and is part of the Chesterfield Sculpture Trail which links in with Newbold, Ashgate, Linacre Reservoirs and Cutthorpe.

The Holme Brook runs through the park from Linacre Reservoirs and in the brook can be found Bullheads, Trout and Crayfish. The northern end of the park is elevated and offers spectacular views over Chesterfield to Hardwick Hall and Bolsover Castle.

• Facilities – Café – Sensory Garden – Lake – Children's Activity Area – Adventure Activities & Outdoor Fitness Machines - Football Pitches – Orienteering Course – Fishing Permits available [enquire] – Cycle paths – Local Inns close by.

There are 2 pay and display car parks – 1 at the Cafe & 1 near the Lower Lake.

• Café – Refreshments can be obtained from the excellent café – see the website for opening times.

- Toilets There are toilets at the café.
- Path The path from the car park near the Lower Lake is quite flat and is a good surface for wheelchairs and continues around the lake. It is made up of fine rolled-in

crushed stone all the way round — it is suitable for motorised wheelchairs but manual wheelchairs will definitely require a pusher for some slopes [ see maps ].

You can start the walk at the main café, but this path down to the lake [ marked in red – see map ] is on a sloping crushed stone path which is suitable for a motorised wheelchair, but a manual wheelchair with a pusher will find it is probably too steep.


