The Matlock Park walk is from Matlock to Matlock Bath along the river Derwent and 2.4 miles long and is a scenic riverside and cliff walk. The 5 parks are called Hall Leys Park, Pic Tor, High Tor, Lovers Walk and Derwent Gardens and is a pleasant riverside walk with gardens, monuments, grand pavilion and many other features. The paths are well paved and friendly to pushchairs and wheelchairs

Matlock and Matlock Bath has many events happening throughout the year including the famous Matlock Bath illuminations, Matlock Aquarium, The Heights of Abraham and is a bustling town and well worth a visit.

• **Facilities** – Close by Matlock shops and cafes – The Heights of Abraham – Matlock Aquarium – Matlock Baths Illuminations.

There are car parks close by the riverside walk at Matlock station, Matlock Aquarium, Matlock Baths station, and Derwent Gardens.

• Café – In Matlock there are plenty of excellent Cafes and Public Houses.

• **Toilets** – There are a number of toilets on the walks at Matlock station, and other public toilets on the trail at Matlock Baths station and Derwent Gardens. Also toilets in all the cafes and public houses.

• **Path** - The paths are made up of tarmac, a mixture of rolled-in crushed stone, and paved areas all along the riverside walk through the park, there are a few sloping areas – it is suitable for all wheelchairs but manual wheelchairs will need a pusher and assess the walk individually.




